Notes for Team Managers and Competitors

- Check In** On arrival please check in your competitors and inform the check in clerk of any withdrawals.
- Warm Ups** A TWO Warm-Up System will be in operation with a controlled Warm-Up before competing.
- Format** Each event will consist of a Set Routine and a Voluntary Routine.
Grade 'D' – Top 8 in each event will compete a Final (**Accumulative Scores**).
- Tariff Limits** Grade '8' – Limit is 1.5
Grades 'H'-'G' – No Tariff Awarded – Emphasis is on good form
Grades 'D', 'E' & 'F' – See Page 2
- Protests** Coaches or Team Managers may approach the Chair of the Panel in a polite manner.
The decision of the Chair of the Panel is final.
- Jewellery** **NO Jewellery or Friendship Bracelets to be worn when Competing or Warming Up**
- Spotters** All competitors must have FOUR spotters who must be wearing the correct attire, i.e. track suit, trainers, NO jewellery or Friendship Bracelets.
- Awards** The first three in each age group will receive a trophy, and the winning teams will receive medals. Each Competitor will be awarded a Certificate, these will be sent to each club with a set of results.
- Presentations** Shortly after the completion of each event a presentation will take place at the trophy table will all competitors gather at the trophy table at the end of their event.
- Timings** **The Organisers reserve the right to run events up to 1 Hour earlier than scheduled**
- Qualifying Scores** For qualifying scores see page 2
Please Note : There are New Qualifying Scores from January 2010.
- Tie Breaker** **There is a tie breaker rule in force at all Competitions as per FIG Rules. (There are no Equal Places).**
- Competition Attire** **For Grades 'D' to 'G' : as per National Grading Structure See Page 4.**

“When submitting entries for a British Gymnastics event the onus is on the club and coaches to ensure that the coaches attending to the participants are qualified to the level of the participants' performance”.

THE COACH RESPONSIBLE MUST SIGN IN AT THE CHECK-IN DESK BEFORE ANY COMPETITORS FROM THEIR CLUB WILL BE ALLOWED TO WARM-UP OR COMPETE.

SCORING INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

There are FIVE form Judges and a Superior Judge. Each form judge will mark the routine out of 10 marks. The judge can deduct up to 0.5 from each move for form.

This deduction depends upon how well or badly the move is executed. The judges deductions are then added up and taken from 10 marks giving the form score.

Out of the 5 judges the highest and lowest scores are ignored and the 3 middle scores are added together for a fair form score.

Each competitor will execute one compulsory routine (Set) and one voluntary routine (Vol). In the Compulsory they must perform the prescribed moves in the sequence outlined. If they deviate the routine is terminated. In the voluntary routine, they perform 10 moves of their own choice.

Each move has a tariff value and the tariff is added to the form score. Obviously the more complex the move the greater the tariff value.

**The top Eight competitors in Grade 'D' will compete in a final round (Accumulative Scores).
There are no Finals for Grades 'E' to 'H'**

PROTECTION OF CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE ADULTS POLICY

Use of Video or Close Range Photography

British Gymnastics Child Protection Policy requires that the name and address of any spectator who wishes to use a camera to video, or take photographs to record the activities at a competition or festival, be registered.

In line with this requirement, the promoters of this event require that any person wishing to engage in any videoing, or photography should have registered their details with staff at the spectator entry desk before carrying out any such photography. Proof of identity will be required. An accreditation identity sticker must be worn at the event at all times.

The organiser reserves the right to decline entry to this event to any person with a camera who has not registered with the organiser. Unregistered persons found to be using a camera will be asked to leave the arena and surrender any film relating to the event.

Competition Attires Grades 'D-G'

The Committee are concerned that some Competitors are not conforming to the dress requirements.
Competitors must conform to the requirements in the National Grading Structure or they will not be allowed to compete.

Female

Leotard, either a sleeveless leotard or a leotard with sleeves a minimum of 2/3rds the length of the arm and white trampoline shoes or plain white foot covering.

Long tights may be worn either flesh colour or same colour as leotard (must be **skin tight**).

In BG competitions for levels D and below female gymnasts may wear small skin tight shorts in a colour and style matching the leotard

Male

Sleeveless leotard and single colour gym trousers and trampoline shoes /foot covering in the same colour as gym trousers or white as per competition rules.

Note: - Black or dark coloured trousers are not permitted.

Shorts are not permitted.

Team Members - Team Members must wear matching clothing as above.
